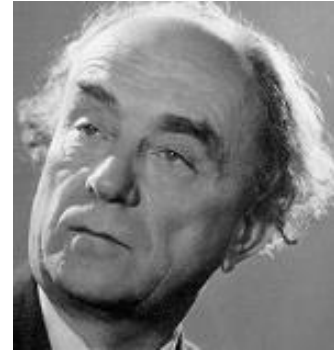


# József Öveges Award

**Deed of Foundation**  
in a uniform structure  
in force from 20. June 2013.



## Section 1

The Board of the Hungarian Nuclear Society establishes a prize named after the famous Hungarian physics professor of the XXth century, József Öveges, to promote the experimental character of physics education in school, and to recognize the physics teachers who perform and develop easy and creative physics experiments in schools.

## Section 2

The József Öveges Award is a bronze medal. With the medal the award receives also a diploma attesting the award. The award also receives a lump sum with the award honoring the development of his/her physics experiments. The amount is determined by the Board of the Hungarian Nuclear Society, and will be published by the Board of Trustees of the Award every year when the application for the Award is launched.

## Section 3

Physics teachers can apply for the József Öveges Award with their teaching work experiments. The deadline for submitting the applications is announced by the Board of Trustees at the beginning of each year. The submitted applications will be evaluated and scored by the Board of Trustees. The scores for the application are added to the half of the points collected in previous years. The points obtained in previous years are always halved, even if the applicant did not submit an application in that year. Only those applications can be considered, which get non-zero scores for both the Professional Content and the Easy School Feasibility. Every year the physics teacher will be awarded, who has the largest score after this evaluating procedure. The scores of the winner will be reset, but in the following years he/she can continue to participate, collect scores, and win the award again.

## Section 4

Members of the Board of Trustees of the Award are elected by the Board of the Hungarian Nuclear Society. The President of the Board of Trustees will be elected from and by the members themselves. Members of the Board of Trustees do not receive remuneration, their mandate is until revocation. Members of the Board of Trustees are dismissed by the Board of the Hungarian Nuclear Society.

## Section 5

The members of the Board of Trustees evaluate the applications individually according to the following criteria and scores. All entries must be evaluated by at least two Board members.

Professional content	max. 20 points
Easy school feasibility	max. 12 points
New content	max. 10 points
Connect with modern physics	max. 10 points
Suitability for student experiment	max. 10 points
Contact with nuclear knowledge	max. 8 points
<b>Total</b>	<b>max. 70 points</b>

The final score is the average of the scores given by the members of the Board of Trustees. After having scored the submitted applications individually, the Board of Trustees will hold a meeting, which will summarize the results and determine the person for the Award. If all members of the Board of Trustees agree, the consultation can be done also electronically.

#### **Section 6**

The submitted work is code named; therefore the applicant should not be named in the application at any time. A sealed envelope must be attached to the application, the outside of which contains the code name of the application, inside the applicant's name and contact data. This envelope will be opened by the secretary of the Society only after the Board of Trustees has scored all entries.

#### **Section 7**

By submitting the application the applicant agrees that

- his/her name and the obtained scores will be published on the website of the Öveges Award;
- in the case of the awardee, the Board of Trustees is entitled to select from the experiments described in the application, which deem to qualify for publishing in the Öveges Award website, from where it can be freely downloaded and used for educational purposes. The applicant may at any time request the removal of his/her name, his/her scores and the description of his/her experiments from the website, but then his/her scores are lost.

#### **Section 8**

The József Öveges Award is handed over to the winner by the President of the Hungarian Nuclear Society at the Nuclear Society's Annual General Assembly.

#### **Section 9**

The awardee should deliver an approx. 20 minute presentation at the General Assembly, where the most important works should be shown, which led to winning the award.

#### **Section 10**

The József Öveges Award will be terminated if the Board of the Hungarian Nuclear Society decides so, or if the Hungarian Nuclear Society is terminated.

The present Deed of Foundation is based on the foundation document issued in March 2006 which was modified and amended by the Board of the Hungarian Nuclear Society on the 20. June 2013.
